**Takeaway:** The remnant is the people God remembers and restores.

### Questions:

1. The word *shachath* (“corrupt,” “ruined”) repeats several times in Genesis 6. What does that repetition help you notice or feel about the world Noah lived in?
2. What part of Noah’s story feels closest to your own experience right now?
3. Where have we, as a church, felt like we were waiting for the waters to recede — and how have we seen signs of dry land beginning to appear?
4. What does it stir in you to think of the remnant not as “what’s left,” but as the people with whom God chooses to begin again?

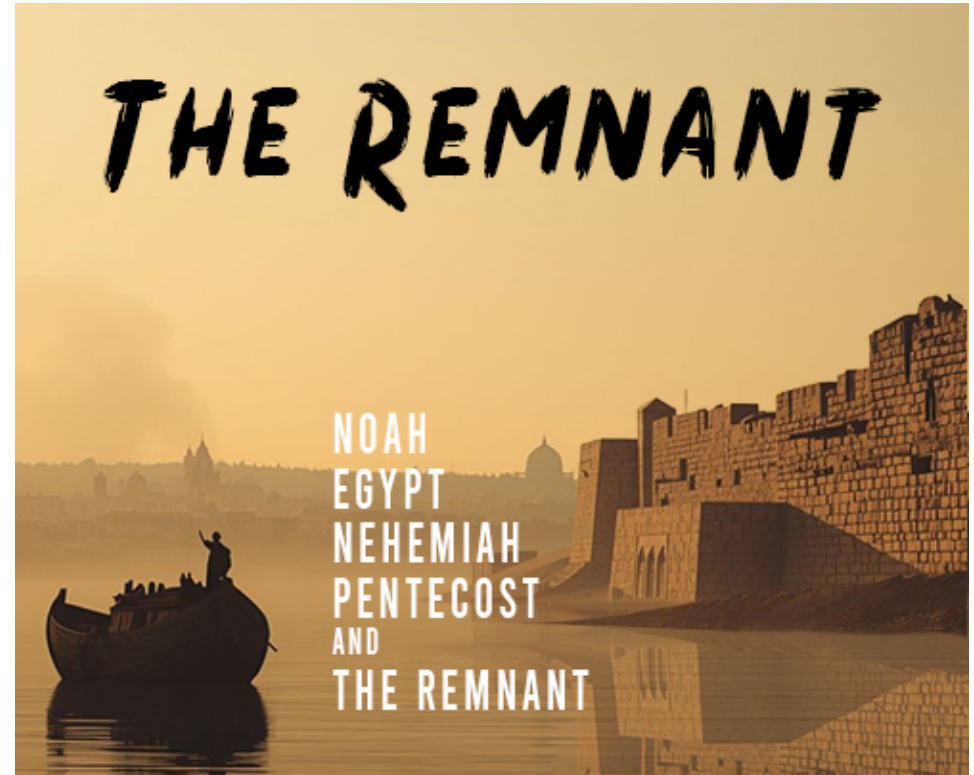
