Message Reflections

Takeaway: There are times we need to change direction. Surrendering our plans opens us to the transforming work of Christ.

Questions:

1. Reflect on a time when your plans were interrupted or changed. What was difficult about that moment? What did you learn?
2. When Jesus confronted Saul (Acts 9:1-6), he asked, "Why are you persecuting me?" If Jesus were to lovingly confront you today, what would he say?
3. Ananias struggles with going to visit Saul (Acts 9:10-17). What can we learn from his conversation with God, before he surrenders and goes to visit Saul at Straight Street?
4. Saul's story doesn't end with conversion. Instead, it's a new beginning. He's sent out "on mission", invited to participate in what God was doing in the world. Where might God be inviting you to join in His work today?
