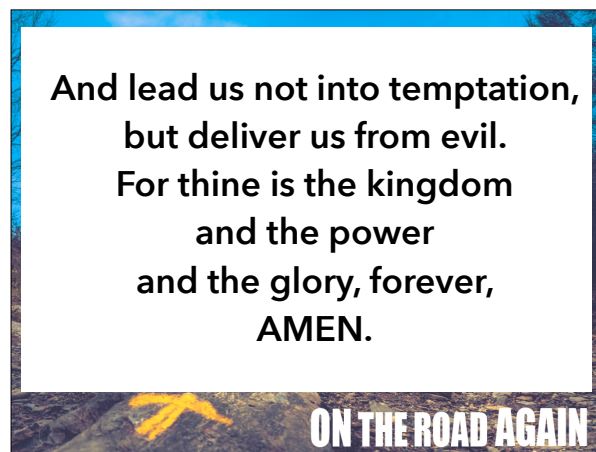
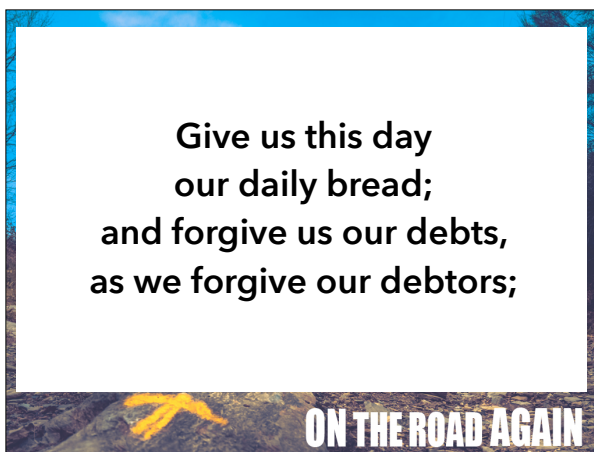
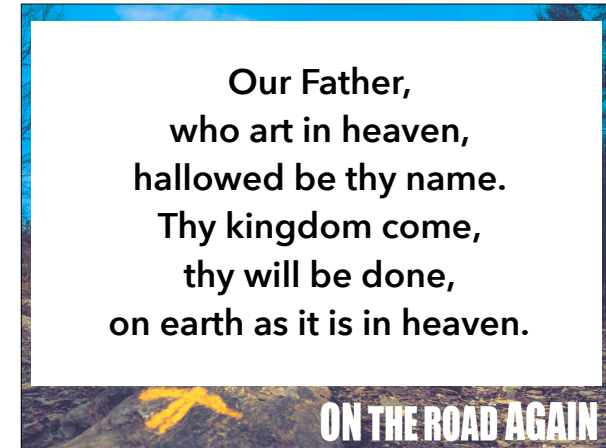
ON THE ROAD AGAIN
